Middlebury Public Library Code of Conduct for Library Patrons

The Rules listed below are posted for everyone's comfort and protection:

- Please keep voices and activities at a level that will not disturb others around you.
- Smoking and alcohol is not permitted.
- Soliciting is not allowed in the library.
- Cell phone use is permitted in the café only.
- No pets are allowed except for service animals.
- Misuse of bathrooms is prohibited.
- Any individual or group using disruptive or abusive language, unacceptable behavior, or otherwise creating a hostile environment will be asked to leave the Library.
- Parents must supervise their children. Any child under the age of twelve (12) should not be left unattended and are subject to the Code of Conduct as stated above.
- Removing library materials from the premises without authorization is prohibited.

We ask your cooperation in maintaining an environment that provides an enjoyable use of the Library. Failure to observe these rules may cause patron to lose library privileges. Illegal activities will be referred to the proper authorities.

The Middlebury Police Department may be called if necessary.
