Rules for Participants

1. Teams may consist of up to 10 people.
2. Feel free to access the library resources when you are not working on the puzzle – computers, magazines and books as well as WiFi are available.
3. Competition will begin at **4:30 PM** and end promptly at **7:30 PM**. We will use the library clock as the official time keeper.
4. Coffee and donuts will be provided by the Friends of Middlebury Library, but because of the timing, entrants may bring bag dinners or pizza to eat in the café or Meeting Room.
5. The winner will be the team who has the most continuously connected puzzle pieces in the allotted time – clusters will not be counted. The team with the least amount of pieces left is the winner! Judge's decision is final.
6. Use your imagination: create a name for your team and wear silly hats or signs. Families and friends are welcome to enter. There is no age limit.
7. All **1,000** piece puzzles are identical and are unopened until the time of the contest.
